### DESIGN

consideration, providing access to power outlets and Wi-Fi for convenience. Lighting and ambience were carefully planned, using both natural and artificial sources to create a welcoming atmosphere. Compliance and safety were paramount, adhering to building codes and ensuring accessibility for all users. Colors were selected to enhance the overall aesthetic, with a focus on creating a warm and inviting atmosphere.



### BUILD

**INSTALLATION CHALLENGES:** The layout was designed to facilitate efficient flow of diners and minimize congestion during peak hours. The seating capacity was

Accessibility was ensured by providing ramps and clear pathways, making the cafeteria easily accessible to all employees, including those with mobility challenges. ## FURNISH
