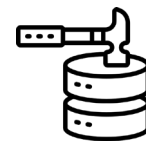
## LPS DIRECT DESIGN, BUILD AND FURNISH A HOME OFFICE

Acoustic treatment involved implementing soundproofing options such as door seals, acoustic panels, and thick rugs to reduce noise and maintain privacy and concentration. Lighting installation involved a combination of natural light and adjustable artificial lighting solutions to reduce glare and minimize eye strain. The ergonomic focus involved positioning furniture to support comfortable posture, considering monitor height, keyboard placement, and the need for occasional standing or stretching.



## FURNISH

**DESIGN SELECTIONS:** The home office was furnished with an ergonomic chair and desk to promote good posture and comfort over long periods, reducing the risk of back pain



and strain. Efficient storage solutions, such as bookshelves and filing cabinets, were implemented to keep essential documents and supplies organized and easily accessible. Adequate lighting was ensured through a combination of natural light and task lighting to minimize eye strain. Technology needs were met by allocating space for essential technology, including computers, printers, and monitors, ensuring they were positioned for ease of use and to prevent clutter. Personalized decor, including items that inspire and motivate, such as plants, artwork, and personal mementos, was added to create a pleasant and stimulating work environment.
